CHAIRMAN'S REPORT



Dear Club Members,

It is with much pride and pleasure that I present a snapshot of Cabarita Beach Bowls & Sports Club's activities and trading for the past twelve months ending 30th June 2016.

Firstly, my thanks are extended to all the Board Directors, the General Manager, Nick Brabham and the staff of the club for the highly professional support they provided me over that period. Special thanks are extended to Jack McArdle and Neal Ambrose who resigned as Directors in 2016. Jack performed the role of Greens Director over a number of years and had a good working relationship with Dave Perez and his staff. The Board was fortunate enough to have Greg Dryden replace Jack McArdle as a Director of our club. Neal Ambrose's legal background and his analytical thinking were utilised on many occasions while he was a Director on the Board.

Financially, our club has witnessed a significant increase in our Operating Profit over the last couple of years. In the 2013/2014 financial year, we had an operating profit of \$292,293 and this increased by 47% to \$430,848 in the 2014/2015 financial year. In this financial year, our Operating Profit was \$484,782 which was a 12.5% increase on the previous financial year. Even though we had a 2.8% decrease in liquor income and a 4.4% increase in overall expenses, the outstanding result in Operating Profit was mainly achieved by a 9.6% (\$173,502) increase in our net return from poker machines. Our Net Profit for the financial year was \$256,193.

Throughout 2015/16 financial year, the Board continued to closely monitor our financial benchmarks and at the same time spent a considerable amount of time and effort in planning for the continued viability and future of our club.

At the end of 2015, the Board considered the option of a Child Care Centre being built on one of our greens. After consulting with a number of key players in the industry and carefully showing due diligence to the other information collected, the Board decided not to proceed.. I would like to acknowledge and thank Neal Ambrose (Director) for the outstanding contributions he made in ensuring that we came to the correct decision on this proposal for our club. There is no doubt that we need to continue our search for other income sources as we plan for the next 5-10 years.

At the beginning of 2016, the Board engaged an outside consultancy firm to ascertain the opinions of our current members on how we can move forward as a club. I would like to acknowledge the contribution made by Nick Brabham in establishing Focus Groups for this exercise and his work with the consultancy firm. The Board received their report and has taken

Immediate steps to incorporate some of their thoughts in our Strategic Plan for the next 5-10 years. For example, the Focus Groups identified the need for our Club to:

- become more family orientated
- have a downstairs café
- have more rewards for members who contribute more funds to our club

As a result, the Board will:

- construct a play area in the corner of Green 3 near the Main Entrance of the club. This area should be completed before the end of 2016.
- implement a tiered loyalty system into our club similar to those systems currently operating in clubs throughout the Tweed.
- re-develop the downstairs bar to incorporate a small café area. This work will be completed by early 2017.

Another important part in our strategies to attract new members to our club and cater for our current members is the provision of attractive, comfortable and safe facilities. In the last financial year, we have renovated the Women's and Men's Toilets at the eastern end of the club. It has been pleasing to see and note the positive responses from our members and visitors who use these facilities. It should be noted that the Board's planning has ensured that all of these improvements around the club have been done without us borrowing any additional money from our bank.

Volunteers continue to play a financial and operational role within the club. I would like to take this opportunity to thank the following groups who have made significant contributions of their time and effort in ensuring our club continues to meet the needs of our members and helps us remain a viable entity:

- The Management Committees of our various Sub-Clubs including Men's & Women's Bowling, golf, fishing, carpet bowls and cricket.
- The men who complete maintenance activities on greens and the surrounds.
- Members associated with organising bowling and catering for visit-ins.
- Other voluntary services around the club.

We had mixed results in 2016 Pennant season. Our Men's Div 2 and Div 4 Pennant teams were successful at the District level but unfortunately did not win at the Zone level. Our ladies were unsuccessful in winning a pennant flag in 2016 but look forward to 2017.

At the end of July 2016, our club co-hosted with Kingscliff the State Div. 7 Pennant Final. The carnival went extremely well and our volunteers are to be congratulated for their efforts. Many congratulatory letters on the running of this event were received from the visiting clubs and we would hope that we will be successful with future applications to host State carnivals as these events add revenue to our club finances. The Cabarita Beach Bowls & Sports Club continues to be 'a hub' of community activities. Finally, my best wishes are extended to you all for the coming festive season.


